## EIGHT BALL COACHING ACCREDITATION

### LEVEL 1

#### △ AEBF Coaching Accreditation Training Program (8hrs)

- The AEBF National Coaching Training Program has been developed to assist coaches to learn the basic skills of coaching. All coaches must satisfy the competencies of each particular level of accreditation. The training program is flexible and can be completed either online or onsite.

#### △ ASC Beginning Coaching General Principles (8hrs)

- The Beginning Coaching General Principles online course has been developed to assist coaches to learn the basic skills of coaching. The online course is currently available free of charge to coaches (<https://learning.ausport.gov.au>) OR contact your state/territory sport and recreation office.

#### △ AEBF Practical Eight Ball Coaching (20hrs)

- A Level 1 Eight Ball Coach need to supply evidence for 20 Hours of Practical Eight Ball Coaching for the completion of the practical requirements of a coaching accreditation, log sheets to record your practical coaching activity have been developed. (Email [coaching@aebf.com.au](mailto:coaching@aebf.com.au))

#### △ AEBF Coach's Code of Conduct

- All coaches wishing to be accredited must have read this code, agree to abide by this code and conduct themselves in accordance with this code when coaching eight ball. Coaches who are deemed to break this Code can have their accreditation withdrawn.

#### △ AEBF Coach's Accreditation Maintenance
